Cantina Sampietrana

68 progressive grape growers in 1952 created Cantina Sampietrana. The winery is located in the Salento area of Puglia (the “heel” of the Italian boot).

Tasting Notes

This Rosato is made from 100% Negroamaro grapes. Aromas of fresh fruit, particularly strawberries, continue with stone fruit and berries on the palate. It is a fresh, dry, and well structured wine with crisp acidity and a pleasingly long finish.

The Cinquantino 50cc scooter is a classic choice for many Italians, as is this 100% Negroamaro Rose.
